
SNOLAB Halloween Pumpkin Carving Pattern

Instructions:

- 1. Cut along the dotted line below to remove the pattern from the instructions.
- 2. Cut a hole in the top of the pumpkin and empty out the seeds so that a light can sit inside.
- 3. Tape the pattern on to the pumpkin and use a pin to poke holes along the lines of the pattern to make a guide for cutting.

- 4. Completely cut out the darker sections.
- 5. Scrape the skin to remove the first few millimetres of the orange flesh off the areas that say "partial carve". This will allow some light to shine through.
- 6. When carving is complete, empty out your pumpkin and place a light inside. Replace lid. (Cover the inside of the lid with aluminum foil if you are using a lit flame).




