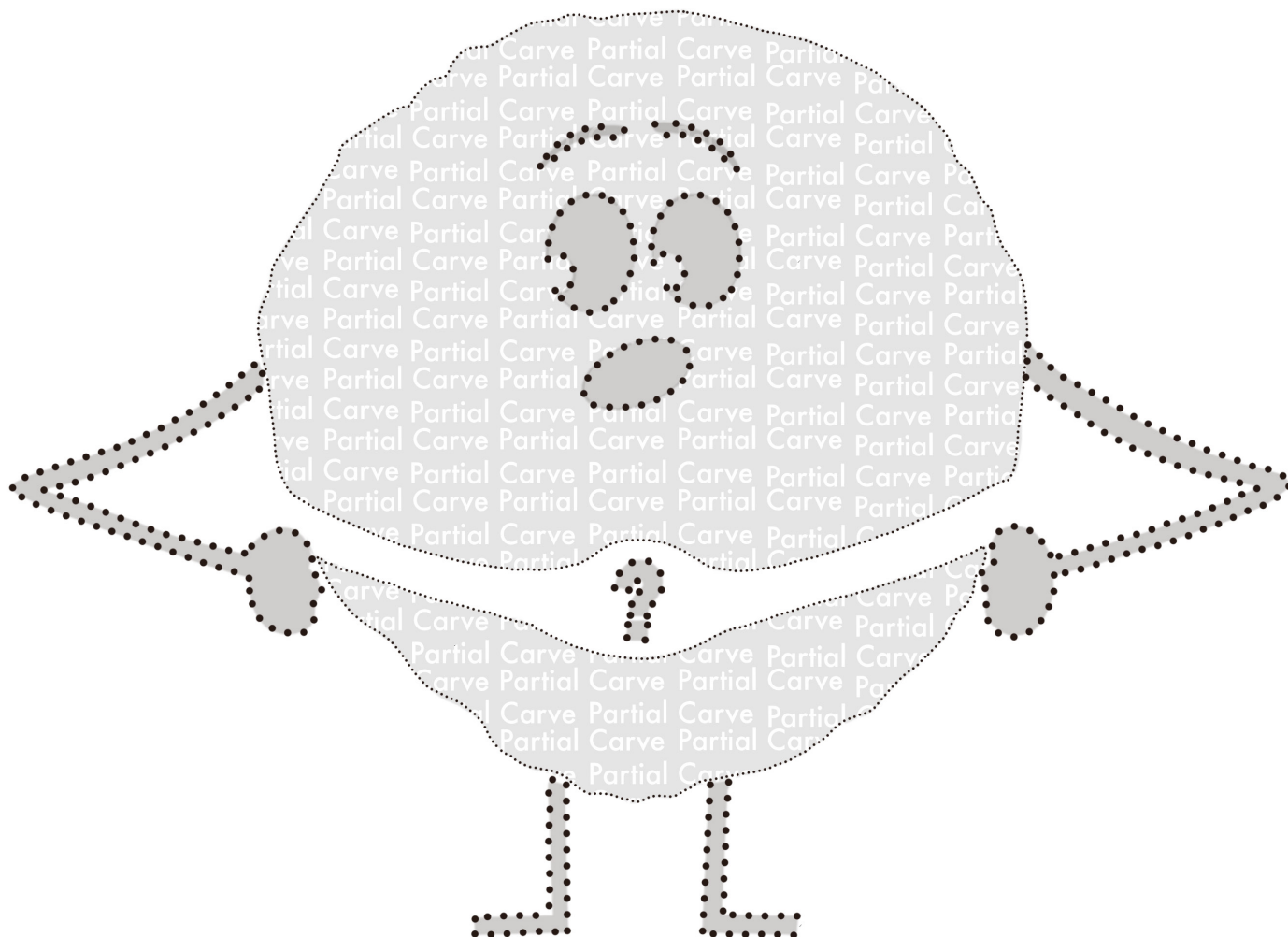


SNOLAB Halloween Pumpkin Carving Pattern

Instructions:

1. Cut along the dotted line below to remove the pattern from the instructions.
2. Cut a hole in the top of the pumpkin and empty out the seeds so that a light can sit inside.
3. Tape the pattern on to the pumpkin and use a pin to poke holes along the lines of the pattern to make a guide for cutting.
4. Completely cut out the darker sections.
5. Scrape the skin to remove the first few millimetres of the orange flesh off the areas that say "partial carve". This will allow some light to shine through.
6. When carving is complete, empty out your pumpkin and place a light inside. Replace lid. (Cover the inside of the lid with aluminum foil if you are using a lit flame).
