SNOLAB is an international facility for world-class underground physics research and has an expanding programme in astroparticle physics and underground science. Located in an air-conditioned clean room 2 km underground in the Vale Creighton Mine near Sudbury Ontario, with a suite of surface facilities and laboratories, SNOLAB is currently preparing for the next generation of experiments focusing on neutrino studies and the search for galactic dark matter.

The Position

The position works to manage all aspects of the SNOLAB image and is responsible for managing the communications risks and opportunities. The Senior Communications Officer is tasked with managing the flow of information both internally and externally. The position works closely with the Education and Outreach Officer to divide public engagement and is tasked with the management of community affairs, public outreach, coordination of community groups, and the dissemination of science related information.

The position will be responsible for:

- Developing communication strategies for delivery of corporate culture and deliver communication objectives
- Supporting management communications to various stakeholders
- Monitoring Provincial and Federal legislation affecting science and maintaining awareness of issues that may impart SNOLAB





Criteria

A Bachelor's degree in physics, chemistry, or related degree in science and engineering.

An additional degree or diploma with a focus in Public Relations, Journalism or Communications

Experience:

- Experience working in a communication role.
- Demonstrated proficiency with communication best practices.

- Demonstrated strong verbal and written communication skills in English (French a considerable asset).
- Excellent proofreading and editing skills in English (French a considerable asset).
