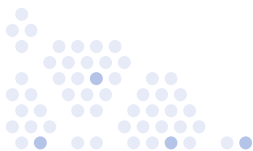
### About Us

SNOLAB is an international facility for world-class underground physics research and has an expanding program in astroparticle physics and underground science. Located in an air-conditioned clean room 2 km underground in the Vale Creighton Mine near Sudbury Ontario, with a suite of surface facilities and laboratories, SNOLAB is currently preparing for the next generation of experiments focusing on neutrino studies and the search for galactic dark matter.

### The Position

This Project Engineer is responsible for supporting projects and experiments with technical support, project coordination and engineering services. The Project Engineer is assigned to projects or work packages and can act as a sub-system manager to the applicable Project Manager or Research Scientist. Work packages and tasks could include all or part of design, procurement, contract administration, construction, commissioning as well as continued support to experiments in operation. The role is considered “hands-on” where the Project Engineer will lead or support plant commissioning and operations, experiment assembly or disassembly, and other similar functions. The selected candidate will be expected to:

- Provide support to users and SNOLAB Research Scientists with troubleshooting, installation, assembly or disassembly of experiments, systems and/or equipment as required.
- Facilitate and conduct engineering and safety assessments such as hazard and operability studies, trade studies, confined space plans, etc.
- Support overall project design and engineering requirements as well as product quality management

- When applicable, responsible for planning and ensuring safe handling of hazardous chemicals and to provide appropriate responses to any incidents.

### Experience:

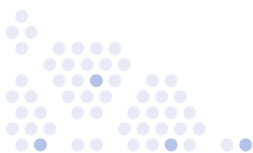
- Five (5) years or more relevant experience.

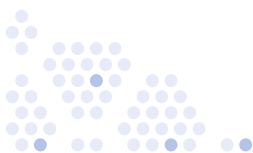
