The Position

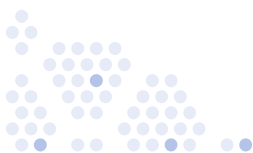
This position supports the daily operations of a one-of-a-kind underground research facility. Cleaner maintainers help maintain one of the deepest, cleanest environments on the planet.

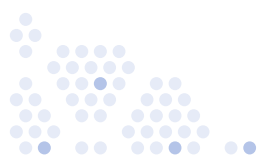
Education:

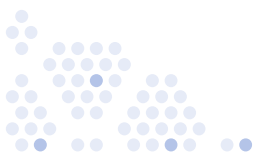
SNOLAB thanks all applicants for their interest, however, only those candidates considered for an interview will be contacted.
