About Us

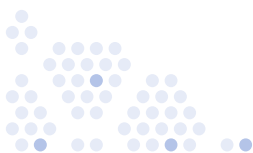

SNOLAB operates in a controlled, air-conditioned clean-room environment, supported by a suite of surface facilities and laboratories, supported by a multidisciplinary team of scientists, engineers, skilled tradespeople, technical staff, and support staff.

By hosting and enabling the world's most advanced and sensitive underground experiments, SNOLAB bolsters Canada's scientific reputation, attracts new talent to our country and Northern Ontario, trains more highly skilled people, provides more opportunities for Canadian researchers to lead international projects, and generates economic benefits for Ontarians and Canadians.

About the Role

Mechanical Maintainers are primarily responsible for moving materials and performing maintenance and repairs to industrial machinery, air conditioning and laboratory equipment. Mechanical Maintainers are expected to operate locomotives for the tramping of materials and forklifts for loading and unloading railcars and moving supplies. This role is also expected to install non-specialized systems or support technical experts with the installation of specialized systems. The position may require compliance with SNOLAB's Sewage Handling Procedure.

- Operate heavy equipment including the locomotive (tram) and forklift as required.
- Change filters, perform checks, clean and lubricate equipment such as the chiller, pumps, STP, air handlers, laboratory equipment and compressors.
- Complete documentation regarding the receipt and shipment of materials using either a paper-based system, ReQlogic or any other logistics systems.
- Routine troubleshooting, adjustments and repairs of equipment.
- Mechanical support for trades and technical staff as required.

- Provide support for basic installations and fabrication using hand and power tools.
- Erect and install scaffolding, hoisting equipment and rigging as per recognized standard practices.
- Dismantle structures and equipment when required.
- Keep work areas tidy and organized.
- Document completed work as required.
- Communicate ideas for improving work flow or other task improvements.
- Adhere to stated policies and procedures relating to health and safety, quality management and quality assurance.
- Participate in preventative maintenance programs for all conventional laboratory systems and subsystems.

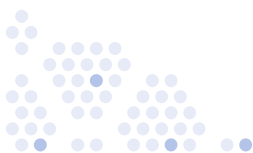

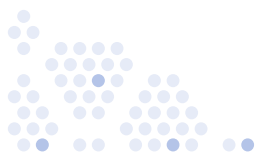
